TOOLS AND SUPPLIES REQUIRED

- 1 roll of masking tape
- 1 spool of string
- 1 tape measure

INSTALLATION

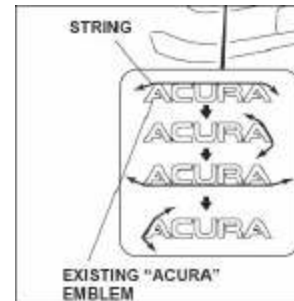
You can get the Integra badge just about anywhere. It generally costs between \$20-\$25 USD.

I. DEBADGING THE OEM ACURA BADGE

1. First, apply a piece of masking tape on the lower edge of the ACURA emblem:

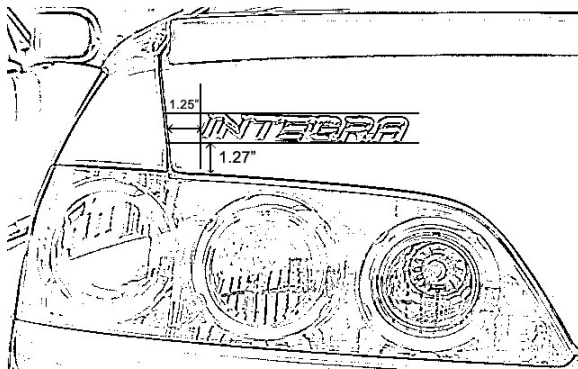


2. Then use a piece of string and "saw" off the adhesive backing of the emblem to separate it from the hatch:



3. This will take some time, but you want to take your time so you don't break the ACURA emblem which can inadvertently scratch your hatch. If there are adhesive left over, you can peel them off with your fingernails. If they are old, you may need to scrub it off with some rubbing alcohol.

- Next, align the Integra emblem on the masking tape and temporarily secure it on the hatch with two masking tapes. Measure with your tape measure 1.25" from the edge of the hatch to the bottom tip of the "I" in the Integra emblem and then place a piece of masking tape vertically, perpendicular to the "I". The area between the lower edge of the hatch to the baseline of the Integra emblem should measure approximately 1.27" :



- Align the emblem so it is straight. You may need to make several attempts before getting satisfactory results.

To secure the emblem onto the hatch, peel off about 1.0" of adhesive backing from the Integra emblem and apply pressure.



Continue peeling out the adhesive backing while applying pressure to the emblem :
